Anhorn served in the Maine House of Representatives from 1971 to 1975 and in the Maine Senate from 1975 to 1979. Biography Anhorn was born in Old Town, Maine, on March 13, 1914, the son of Oscar and Lillian (Ellison) Anhorn. He graduated from Old Town High School and attended Maine Central Institute. He served in the United States Army during World War II. He was a member of the Maine House of Representatives from 1971 to 1975 and in the Maine Senate from 1975 to 1979. Anhorn was defeated for renomination in the Senate in 1978 by Gordon M. Fournier of Westbrook. Anhorn died on April 12, 2006.
